He has presented to 70+ apprenticeship programs in 4 states reaching almost 4,000 apprentices. He donates all of his speaking fees to progressive organizations and candidates, and people in need.

He "retired" 7 years ago after serving as the Regional Representative for U.S. Secretary Hilda Solis for the 8 Pacific NW and northern plains states.

He currently serves on the Education, Training and Apprenticeship Committee of the Washington State Labor Council, AFL-CIO, the Board of the Puget Sound Advocates for Retirement Action and the founding chair of their Education Committee, and the Advisory Committee of the WA State Labor and Education Research Center.
